model which focuses overly on food and medications in treating these conditions which actually misses the deeper underlying issues. On unmasking these issues, we find that there is often a tyranny at home around food which is accompanied with the young person's fear of emotional rejection from the peer group and of the world outside. Young people with eating disorders are often split between regression on the one hand and taking on family issues from a very early age on the other. Anorexia keeps young people trapped in a "Peter Pan" syndrome where a refusal to grow is embodied by a distorted self-perception while bulimia is often associated with mood and personality disorders. Obesity might become a form of emotional protection – a barrier between self and the world. If we move out of the medical description, we might think that ED are an extreme act of adolescent rebellion and signal an exasperated search for care and love.

Join this workshop to discover innovative ways of working with anorexic, bulimic & obese clients in the context of their extended families using a multigenerational approach according to the Andolfi model. You will learn how to create an alliance with the problem-child and to give competence back to the young person, You will learn how to activate resources in the extended family, in the peer group and in the community. Last but not least, you will learn how to use yourself freely in psychotherapy and counselling adopting a humanistic, creative approach. Taped clinical cases will be shown and discussed. If possible, live presentations will be included. Maurizio Andolfi, Child Psychiatrist, Prof. of Clinical Psychology, University La Sapienza in Rome is the Director of the International Family Therapy Academy (Italy). He is an internationally renowned Master Family Therapist. He was awarded for his special contribution to family therapy by AAMFT in 1999 and from the Australian Association of family Therapy in 2021. He received a Lifetime Achievement Award from AFTA In 2016. Andolfi relocated to Australia in where he was conferred with the title of Distinguished Talent from the Australian Government and continues to teach around the world. He is also an Honorary Member of the Asian Family Therapy Association and of the World Social Psychiatry Association. He is the author of several bestselling books including, "Teen Voices", "Multigenerational Family Therapy", "The Intergenerational Couple Therapy" and "The Gift of Truth".
